

Welcome to Beadnell

Stretching from the harbour is the long golden sweep of Beadnell bay with the ruined Dunstanburgh Castle in the distance. This sheltered bay makes an ideal location for some of the best sailing and wind surfing on the Northumberland coast.

Uniquely for a harbour on the East coast of Britain, the harbour entrance faces west which allows views of stunning sunrises and sumptuous sunsets. This combination of charm and accessibility makes Beadnell a popular holiday village on the North East coast.

A Brief History

The earliest evidence of settlements in Beadnell is dated from a polished stone axe found at Annstead from the Neolithic period. There have also been artifacts found spanning the Bronze, Iron and Roman age – cementing Beadnell's long and colourful history. There are several buildings in the parish that date to the medieval period. The present chapel of St Ebba being the key focal point.

In the later medieval period, there was an increased threat from raiders from over the border in Scotland, as well as from Northumberland, a fortified tower house was built. Remains can still be seen around the Village today.

In the post-medieval period Beadnell got much of its wealth from the sea. The small harbour was built in the 18th century. The fishing boats working from this harbour mainly went after herring, which were dried in a now demolished drying house and exported. The harbour also exported lime made in the lime kiln on the harbour itself and on Beadnell Point. In the late 19th century the fishing industry in the village began to decline. The herring shoals were getting smaller, and there was a move amongst British fishermen to use larger steam-powered trawlers, which the small fishermen of Beadnell could not afford.

Another, less reputable, source of income existed in the form of smuggling. This was a thriving, if illegal, industry. It is believed that the smugglers tunnels run right under Beadnell to the cellar of Beadnell Towers and beyond.

Today the main role of the village is as a centre for tourism. The sheltered waters of Beadnell Bay are ideal for water sports, and if you're feeling brave you can shore dive around the reefs off Beadnell Point and view the wreck of the MV Yewglen, which ran aground in 1960.

Our owners acquired Beadnell Towers in 2017. The hotel is a historic, Grade II listed building, dating back to the 18th century. It has been and remains at the heart of the community of this Northumbrian coastal village for more than two centuries. Our sympathetic refurbishment of the building in 2019 aimed to keep as much of the character of the building as possible, whilst at the same time offering a boutique feel, home comforts, a touch of elegance and a splash of style. Each of our 22 rooms is as individual as the rest, part of a living, historic building and as such no two are the same in size, shape or feature.

Distilled and bottled on the Holy Island of Lindisfarne. Match this with Fever Tree Ginger Ale.

Gins

Hepple Gin

There is an immediate fresh scent of green apple, bright grapefruit and spicy juniper. This then opens up to reveal underlying notes of Douglas Fir, and fragrant blackcurrant.

Holy Island Gin

With eleven carefully selected botanicals including: juniper, nutmeg, elderberries, sweet orange peel, rose petal and hibiscus, this gin is sweet and floral but with an undeniable juniper kick.

Hendricks Gin

Big, creamy aromas right off the bat, with a little zesty citrus, juniper, rose petal jelly and cucumber. Astoundingly fresh notes of cucumber with juniper, oak, a touch more citrus and vanilla. Creamy and savoury. A long, refreshing, floral finish.

Tanqueray Gin

Tanqueray was the first ever gin to be distilled in small batches with fresh citrus fruit. This distillation takes place in a unique copper still called Tiny Ten. It produces a spirit known as the citrus heart which gives Tanqueray its bright, elegant citrus taste.

Whitley Neill Gin

Whitley Neill Gin is slightly softer and much smoother than traditional Gins, with rich notes of juniper and citrus, pot pourri and exotic spices.

Boe Violet Gin

The citrus flavour profile is completely turned on its head and it's the floral and fruity notes that really take hold – intense apple, lavender and berries.

Brockmans Gin

Brockmans is like no other gin. Where the more traditional notes of gin are combined with a refreshing influence of citrus and aromatic wild blackberries and blueberries.

Triple Six Gin

They have extracted and blended botanicals using the essence of Passionflower, Wormwood and Black Walnut to create tinctures which are then used in the triple six distilling process to create a dry gin like no other. Heady and intoxicating in both aroma, taste and appearance.

Their story started in one of England's last wild sanctuaries in the remote moors of Northumberland, the whipping winds amongst the age of juniper bushes at Hepple, and their pursuit of a gin to make the perfect dry martini. The only way to capture the wild heart of this juniper was to completely rethink how the gin was made. So their Triple Technique was born.

Triple Six

Founded by a Beadnell local, Triple Six blends a range of botanicals in its search for the perfect gin. To create the perfect taste, the team took inspiration from ancient apothecarists who created herbal tinctures for potions and remedies. Their team expertly blended botanicals and herbs to create and perfect a tincture that can be used in the distilling process to infuse their gin with a unique bold flavour, taste and aroma.

Rigg & Furrow Brewery

Situated in Morpeth, Northumberland, Rigg & Furrow is an authentic farmhouse brewery. Giving a new lease of life to an old milking parlour they create new takes on Farmhouse beers - beers originally brewed for thirsty farm workers.

Brewing by hand, their independent, family run brewery creates exciting, innovative, fermentation focused beers. Strong favourites here at Beadnell are Run Hop Run, Owl Porter & Land Bier.

Mordue Brewery

The original Mordue Brewery was situated on Wallsend village green and run by Joseph Mordue, a brewer of distinction in the 19th Century. In 1995, over 100 years later, the superb ales were revived and we particularly love Coastal Lager & Summer Tyne.

First & Last Brewery

Established in 2016 in Elsdon, the heart of Northumberland. The First & Last is an award winning, family-run, microbrewery. They brew small batch cask-conditioned, canned and bottled beer which are inspired by the wild, untamed landscape and dark skies of Northumberland. We stock Red Rowan and Equinox.

Hadrian Border Brewery

The foundations were laid on 9th June 1994 when they took over the Border Brewery Company in Berwick upon Tweed. At that time Farne Island was the best selling beer and it was being brewed twice a week to keep up with demand. The search was on for a bigger plant.

In 2000 the Four Rivers brewery in Byker Newcastle went into liquidation. The Four Rivers had originally been called the Hadrian Brewery so they changed the company name to Hadrian and Border, the border, now north of Berwick and Hadrian's wall were one and the same thing, just in different locations and eras. You have to try Farne Island, Tyneside Blond & Secret Kingdom.
